The local job market for young economists within the 13th Biennial CSE Conference

One of the aims of the 13th Biennial Conference of the Czech Economic Society (CES) is to strengthen interactions between candidates for positions in academic institutions in the Czech Republic and representatives of these institutions. To that end, the Board of CSE agreed on organizing a simple local job market for young economists:

Call for papers

The conference announcements stress the role of the conference as a **local job market for young economists**. The organizers encourage especially early-stage researchers and doctoral candidates who have the prospect of completing their studies soon to submit their best work.

During registration, each author of an accepted article will have the option to mark their contribution as a "job market paper" (JMP). JMP authors are expected to have:

- a serious interest in an academic position in the Czech Republic in a field relevant to economics and business schools
- a personal academic webpage, containing fields of interests, research, CV, and preferably also relevant teaching experience
- announced on the webpage the expected dissertation defense date (typically, but not exclusively, the institutions are interested in having the studies completed by September 2025, with the aim of hiring since WS 25/26).

Conference

The conference organizers will send the full list of the JMPs to **deans and representatives of the Czech academic institutions** with the aim of distributing it to colleagues who are responsible for recruitment. The representatives will also be asked to attend the conference so that they can see and evaluate the presentations of the relevant JMPs and contact the applicants during the conference.

Evaluation

At the end of spring 2025, this informal market will be evaluated with the help of a short survey sent to the authors of the JMP and the representatives of the addressed institutions.
